<p>We expect you to practise reading and writing the daily sound in your Set 1 Speed Sounds Book using the handwriting phase outlined in the book.</p>  <p>Use your sound mat to practise previously taught sounds and try writing some simple CVC (Consonant, Vowel, Consonant) Words such as 'map, sat, fun'</p>	<p>Regularly share story books with a grown up.
