Can you explain the journey of blood around the body?</p>	<p>Be an Artist Explore anatomical drawing (like Leonardo da Vinci). Sketch a part of the human body (hand, heart or skeleton). Focus on detail, proportion and shading.</p>
<p>Be a Designer Design your own Ancient Greek pot (amphora). What patterns and colours were commonly used? Include symbols or scenes that tell a story.</p>	<p>Be a Performer Create a short Greek myth performance. Choose a god, goddess or hero and act out part of their story. Can you use expression and movement to show character?</p>	<p>Be an Engineer Design and build a model of the human heart or a Greek temple. What materials will you use (card, Lego, recycled materials)? How will you make it strong and accurate?</p>
